1. **START NOW** - Please check with your community regarding field availability!
2. **FIRST**, before inquiring about field availability in your area and filling out this form you must print out, read, and completely understand the BRCL Field Policy and Standards for 2005. Available at <http://www.brclsoccer.org/pdf/fields/BRCLFieldStandards.pdf>
3. Please also print the BRCL Field Diagrams for 2004-05, which are pictorial versions of the BRCL Field Standards and will assist you in speaking to the locality from which you will be obtaining fields. <http://www.brclsoccer.org/pdf/fields/BRCLfieldDimensions.pdf>
4. Full Field availability is defined as Saturday and Sunday 1:00 PM till dark, every available play date that is on the BRCL Schedule.
5. Please use the formula on next page to determine the number of fields that your club needs to provide for BRCL Scheduled play.
6. The Field Name and/or Number should be used the entire season and the field clearly identified by signs at the field site.
7. Complete/accurate directions to the field must be provided by email to the BRCL Administrator (BRCLsoccer@cox.net).
8. Club Provided Fields **MUST** be committed, available, and reserved for BRCL play if included on this form.
9. Club Field Coordinator is responsible for developing and managing a timely process deciding IN-SEASON WEATHER-RELATED Club field Closures and the prompt and **TIMELY** notification to ALL HOME and VISITING TEAMS of ANY Field Closures for any Reason.
10. Limited field availability during the season for any reason may mean fewer home games.
